# YB Chavan student tops GPAT 2020

**Parbhani boy Omar Khan bags AIR 1, becoming the first student in M'wada to achieve the rare feat**

Omar Khan is on cloud nine and he has a reason: He has topped the Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT) 2020 by scoring 315 out of 500 in his first attempt, becoming the first student in Marathwada to achieve the rare feat.

The result of the test was announced by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on Tuesday evening. GPAT is conducted for admissions to M Pharm courses in different institutions across the country. This year 48,360 students took the test from across the country, of these 4,913 qualified for it.

Son of a private tutor Moosa Khan and primary schoolteacher Sameena Begum, Omar did his schooling from an Urdu medium school in his hometown Parbhani.

"It is a great feeling to see the fruition of my hard work. I was totally unaware about my result until my coach Mohammed Aslam called me up to break the news. For a moment, I couldn't believe my ears, but soon I came to terms with the fact as I was flooded with calls and messages from teachers and friends. Super excited

on my success, I called my parents in Parbhani to break the news," said Omar, who is currently pursuing final-year B Pharm at YB Chavan College of Pharmacy, Aurangabad.

Sharing his preparation strategy, Omar said, "I am not someone who can sit at length with books. I did not have any routine or fixed study schedule. I studied for only for 2-3 hours daily because I tend to lose focus if I study for long hours at a stretch. When I get bored during studies I take a break, engage myself with some recreational activities and then get back to books. This helps me stay focused. I never reduced my screen time, in fact, I was regular on social media as usual. My success mantra is 'Staying focused and regu-

lar study for semesters.' I was expecting to be among top 25, but never in my dreams I thought of topping the all India merit list."

In a message to aspiring students, Omar suggests having clear concepts about the subject right from the first year of the course. Never memorise things by heart. Attending regular classes, staying focused throughout the semesters, taking lots of mock tests and referring to standard books recommended by NTA help a great deal, he added.

The 22-year-old Omar takes pride in being a student of YBCCP where, he believes, he discovered his worth under the guidance of dedicated and experienced teachers. "Without them, I won't have cracked the test. I am grateful to all my teachers and principal at YBCCP for boosting my morale during the preparation," he added.

When asked about future plans, Omar said he wishes to pursue M Pharm in Pharmaceutical Analysis from the National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPER) and later get into Research and Development.

The elated staff and college principal are also on a high with the new recognition the institution has achieved. "Omar is the first student in the minority institutions in the State who topped the national merit list in GPAT," said principal Dr Zahid Zaheer.
