

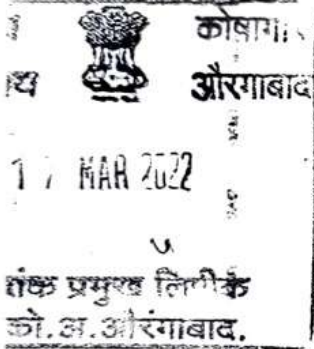

AGREEMENT

The Agreement is entered into on 28th March 2022, at Aurangabad

By and Between

E-RECON RECYCLING ^{Pvt Ltd} having its office at Chikalthana Aurangabad (Therein after referred to as First party" which expression shall unless contrary to and or repugnant to the context mean and include successors representatives and permitted assign) through **Mr. S. Z. Shaikh (Proprietor)** to enter into and

AND

Y. B. Chavan College of Pharmacy, Aurangabad, is the pioneering educational institute with the state of art infrastructure and all modern facilities to cater excellent pharmaceutical education at Dr. Rafiq Zakaria Campus, Aurangabad, thereafter referred to as "Second party" which through **Dr. Abubakar Salam Bawazir, I/c. Principal of the College**, to enter into and this agreement for and on behalf of the Second party.

WHEREAS

The First party, having its works at Gat No. 94, opposite to RL Steel, Paithan Road Chitegaon, and Aurangabad- 431005 is registered as Approved E- Waste Recycler/diamantes by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) under Lic no. BO/MPCB/RO(HQ)/AURANGABAD/CR/B-934/DATE 08/11/2013 of the Hazardous Waste Management & Handling Rules, 1989 as amended in 2003 and is operating facility for the collection, Reception, Transportation, Treatment and Disposal of E-Waste at Chitegaon Aurangabad

The Second party in compliance of the Hazardous Waste Management & Handling Rules 1989 as amended in 2003 desires to have services for disposal of their Electronic Waste Except liquid waste for which the first party is authorized facility of CPCB.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT witnesses the following terms & condition to be performed by both the parties to the agreement.

1. The First Party will require the second party staff representative to sign its Hazardous E-Waste collection document in acknowledgement of E-Waste handed over. The First Party will sign the record book to be maintained by second party as the statutory requirement and has to be compiled with.
2. The second party will arrange collection and ensure proper segregation of Electronic Waste generated from its various sections as per Hazardous Waste (Management & handling Rules 1989) as amended in 2003. The second party shall also ensure that all the E-Waste is handed over to First party.
3. The second party will pack the segregated electronic waste as per the rules at the collection end point in bags/containers with label as per Form 8 of the Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 1989 and keep them ready for collection by first party's collection staff during 10:00 a.m. to 05 p.m. or any other time which may be mutually agreed upon.
4. The Second Party undertake to deliver to the first party only the segregated Hazardous e-Waste generated in mutually decided time period.
5. The Second Party's responsibility will cease once the segregated electronic waste duly packed labelled and signed has been handed over to the first party. It is specifically agreed and understood that compliances of Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 1989 as amended in 2003 during transportation and disposal of electronic waste shall be exclusive responsibility of first party.
6. The First Party will be e-waste recyclers for the Second Party.
7. **This agreement will be in the force for a period of Five years and can be renewed at the end of Five years**

8. (a) Notwithstanding the aforesaid term this Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving 30 days written notice only upon the concurrence of any of the events specified in Clause (I) (II) & (III) mentioned below:

- I) The First Party will be at liberty to discontinue the services to the Second Party in the event the Second Party does not comply with the norms.
- II) The First Party will be within their right to suspend the services to the Second Party in the event of Second Party handing over un-segregated Electronic Waste.
- III) The Second Party shall be at Liberty to discontinue the services of First Party in the event that the First Party commits successive defaults in taking delivery of the Electronic Waste from the Second Party within 15 days after intimation.

9. The Parties will not carry any monetary obligation except the Parties hereby agree to dispose the Hazardous e-Waste, at the rates as per the Schedule 1 of this agreement.
