- 1. Y.B. Chavan College of Pharmacy, Aurangabad, (here in after referred to as "YBCCP" or first party) is the pioneering educational institute with state of art infrastructure and all the modern facilities to cater excellent pharmaceutical education at Dr. Rafiq Zakaria Campus, Aurangabad established in 1989. The College runs Bachelor in Pharmacy (B. Pharm), Master in Pharmacy (M. Pharm) and is Ph.D research centre. The College is affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathawada University, Aurangabad India.
- 2. Shreeyash Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Aurangabad,

 (MS) India. ((here in after referred to as "SYIPER" or Second party), is a fast
 progressing institute established in 2018 at Satara Parisar, Aurangabad. The College
 runs Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm), Bachelor in Pharmacy (B. Pharm) and Master
 in Pharmacy (M. Pharm) courses. The College is affiliated to Affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb
 Ambedkar Technological University, Lonere, Raigad, India.

The Colleges, YBCCP and SYIPER are agreed for mutual Collaboration with respect to following points;

The objective of this MOU is mutual benefit to the student and faculty members of both the Colleges with academic information sharing, collaborative research, skill development, training and quality improvement.

- 1) Collaborative Research: Both Colleges having the competent faculties and good infrastructure for research. The faculty and students of both colleges may undertake collaborative research projects to have a good outcome in the form of publications, patents and presentations. The outcome of the research work, any publication, presentation, patent or any intellectual property generated through collaborative research project will have bear the name of both the colleges.
- 2) Facility Shearing: The faculty and students can utilize the research facilities (Instruments, equipments and Laboratory) of each other's college if required after due permission from the Principal of the respective College. The charges if any, for the utilization of facilities will be as mutually decided by the Colleges. The Chemicals,

Solvents and any other consumable if required that will be arranged by the respective College utilizing the facility. Any damage to the Instruments, equipments and Laboratory due to utilization by other college will be the responsibility of the College using the facility.

- 3) Development of Value Added and Skill Development Courses: Both the Colleges may start some value added and skill development short term courses for overall development of the students. The work and financials if any for dunning such courses will be shared as per mutual understanding of the Colleges.
- 4) Quality Development Initiatives: In the view of accreditations like NAAC, NBA and ranking like NIRF; both colleges will help each other for various quality improvement initiatives and documentations within the framework of rules of the respective College and prior permission of the Principal.
- 5) Organising Joint Conference/ Workshop/ Seminar: The colleges may jointly organise any Conference/ Workshop/ seminar/ Career Counselling/ training programs/ on various current topics of mutual interest. The responsibility of work, facility and financials sharing if any will be as per mutual understanding of both the Colleges.
- 6) Joint Students Placement Activities: The Colleges may organize Joint students Placement activities/ Interview drive of various Pharmaceutical industries and related organizations.
- 7) Faculty Exchange: The Colleges may depute Faculty/technical personnel on full-time/part time basis for a limited period not exceeding one week at a time for the purpose of implementation of joint tasks within the areas of co-operation of mutual interest with the due permission of the Management/ Principal without affecting the working of his own College.
- 8) Term of MOU: The term of MOU will be for five years from the date of signing by both the parties and may be renewed afterwards with mutual consent. It may be modified by mutual written consent or terminated by either party with one month advanced notice to other party.
