Among those, drivers were in the profession for 10 to 20 years had one or more complaints. The commonest complaint was musculoskeletal pain. Generalized fatigue, acidity, and headache were other common complaints. This had significant association with age and the number of years in profession. 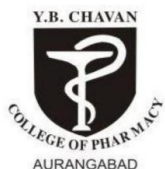

**CONTRIBUTION OF SCIENTIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF COVID-19 VACCINE**

Named as primary contributor, Mihir Metkar is a bioinformatics scientist. He has a degree in MSc from the Institute of Bioinformatics and Biotechnology, located at the Savitribai Phule Pune University. He then pursued PhD at the University of Massachusetts Medical School's RNA Therapeutics Institute in Worcester. Metkar did his post-doctoral fellowship at the same university. In 2018, he started working for Moderna.

**How mRNA Vaccines Work**  
The vaccine spurs healthy cells to produce viral proteins that stimulate a potent immune response.

1. Selecting a potential mRNA sequence that codes for the virus spike protein.
2. The RNA sequence, a blueprint for making the spike, is modified by a lipid coating for delivery.
3. Once it enters cells and the instructions in the mRNA sequence to produce copies of the spike protein.
4. The protein fragments enter the immune system to produce antibodies that can protect against a real virus when it hits the body.

The COVID-19 vaccine by Moderna belongs to a new type called the mRNA (messenger RNA). Unlike the conventional vaccines that use either part or complete dead virus or a modified version of a different virus, mRNA vaccines use genetically engineered messenger RNA particles to activate the body's antibody response. The mechanism of action of mRNA VACCINE as shown in fig.
