The Institute Innovation Cell (IIC) in association with Department of Quality Assurance conducted a field visit in accordance with the IIC Calendar activities for the academic year 2021-22. The activity conducted was on the theme "Exposure and field visit for problem identification". The field survey was conducted to identify the health problems faced by the auto rickshaw drivers of Aurangabad city. Total 24 students and 8 faculty members were participated in activity. It is observed that auto rickshaw drivers are prone to musculoskeletal, respiratory, and gastrointestinal disorders. Auto rickshaw drivers are susceptible to various health-related problems and there is need of monitoring on an ongoing basis. Musculoskeletal pain is very common for which long daily working hours over many years is a contributory factor. Among those, drivers were in the profession for 10 to 20 years had one or more complaints. The commonest complaint was musculoskeletal pain. Generalized fatigue, acidity, and headache were other common complaints. This had significant association with age and the number of years in profession. Auto rickshaw drivers are very susceptible to health-related problems and there is need for monitoring on an ongoing basis to prevent it.

- 4. Time management skills were also developed as it was time bound quiz competition.




Thus, quiz competition benefited the participant as mentioned below.
